EAT

Once you're there, your driver can take you to the Tantalus Estate restaurant to enjoy its rustic tranquility and gourmet delights. It's an expansive, light-filled venue with calming views of vineyards featuring intricate chandeliers created from old vines on the property. Chef Paul Jobin created a tasting menu fit for royalty. His fresh, uncomplicated, contemporary food respects the seasons and the environment.







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TOUR

A private charter jet takes you south to Mahana, formerly known as Woollaston Estates, an organic vineyard and winery located in the Nelson region. With their modern Cellar Door restaurant and luxury Villa Accommodation, Mahana is now one of New Zealand's premier winery destinations. They fuse the cultural themes of wine, cuisine, art, and literature into one immersive experience.





ACTION

Just a 30 minute helicopter ride away from Auckland, surrounded by expansive coastal views overlooking the Hauraki Gulf, is our next stop, Kauri Bay, Clevedon. Time to get your adventure on Kiwi (that's what you call a New Zealander) style.

Kauri Bay Boomrock bills itself 'the ultimate experience venue' with a whole host of thrills and challenges to choose from. Fancy some 4WD Off Roading, Claybird Shooting, Archery, Knife throwing, Flying a Chopper and Extreme Golf? This is the tip of the iceberg of what Kauri Bay has to offer along with lodging, outstanding New Zealand wine and cuisine.









FORAGE

The Marlborough Sounds are an extensive network of seadrowned valleys at the north end of the South Island of New Zealand. This is the area Tania choose for guided food foraging tour with local experts. Learn how to shuck Tio Point oysters, stop at King Salmon farm, tour a salt farm, go crayfish hunting and bring it all back to be prepared at a secret location by your private chef.



ADVENTURE

Nestled in the Southern Alps - backing on to Mt Aspiring National Park and accessible only by helicopter is Minaret Station, explore the wilderness of the South Island with the friendly and experienced Minaret Station team through one of many Heli-Adventure options.
